Fertilizer 1tspn every 5-6 months **R 30.**

Pine Bark Mulch **R 40.**

Berry Mix for all berries, not acidic on it's own for Blueberry & Cranberry **R 40.**

Volcanic Rock Dust – enough for 1 plant – contains at least 72 minerals and

Trace elements to enhance the quality of soils **R 20.**

*Blueberry and Cranberry plants will not survive and fruit if they  
are planted in only acid compost. They **must** have Spagnum peat moss.  
They require a soil PH of 4.2 – 5.5. Full sun, well drained soil.  
Cranberries will do well in partial shade.*
